# Supply of Croatian/Slovenian labelled Rocuronium bromide (Hameln) Solution for injection 10 mg/mL

Max Health Ltd is temporarily supplying Rocuronium bromide (Hameln) Solution for injection 10 mg/mL, Croatian/Slovenian packaging to the New Zealand market, to cover a medicine supply shortage.

Please note that the Croatian/Slovenian and New Zealand products are identical, except for the labelling.


An English overlabel has been applied to the principal display panel of the Croatian/Slovenian carton.


The pack insert is not in English, therefore should be discarded.

### **Differences in labelling:**

The Croatian/Slovenian Rocuronium bromide,10mg/mL is spelled as 'Rokuronijev bromid Hameln 10mg/ml'.





### **PHARMAC Reimbursement**

There is no change as the product will be reimbursed under the Pharmaceutical Schedule in the same way as NZ Rocuronium bromide, 10 mg/mL solution for IV injection/infusion.
